About The Training Program

As an Apprentice, you will learn your trade through a combination of on-the-job training, technical education, and classroom instruction. Our Apprentices have the opportunity to work during the day with Local Union 354 Journeymen who will help and guide you with the tasks at hand. You will attend school two evenings a week and learn first hand from our instructors, who have gone through the program and are currently working with our contractors.

Applications are accepted the THIRD MONDAY of each month from 8:00 AM - NOON. Please choose the location based on your residency.

> Ebensburg JATC School 172 Municipal Road Ebensburg, PA 15931 (for applicants residing in Beford, Blair, Cambria, Cameron, Clearfield, Elk, Huntingdon, Indiana, Jefferson, and Somerset Counties)

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and have a high school diploma or a General Education Development Certificate (GED) and must be physically capable of performing work of outside construction plumbingpipefitting trade, work at various heights and in extreme weather conditions.

We consider applicants for all positions without regard to race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, and veteran status, the presence of a non-job related medical condition or disability, or any other legally protected status.

When you apply to the program, be sure to bring:

- Application Fee of \$40.00 cash or money order (*no personal checks will be accepted*)
- High school transcripts or GED
- Two (2) letters of recommendation (*from former employers, school officials, or non-related persons*)
- Copy of DD-214 form if a veteran
- Must provide a current Pennsylvania Driver's License.

All applications that have been submitted for the Apprenticeship Program will be reviewed for consideration for the next upcoming June class. All applicants will be notified and will be scheduled for interviews at the locations where you applied. Our Journeymen train our apprentices to become the highest skilled tradesmen and tradeswomen in the mechanical construction industry!

During your course of the Apprenticeship, you will have the opportunity to obtain certifications such as, Weld, Medical Gas Braze/Installer, Backflow, EPRI Rigging, OSHA-IO, City of Johnstown Plumbing License, just to name a few.

When you become a 5th Year Apprentice, you will have the opportunity to compete in our Local Union 354 Apprentice Contest. If you are successful in taking first place in your field of your skill competition, you will then go to the PA State Pipe Trades Apprentice Contest and compete against other Local Union Apprentices within the State of Pennsylvania to "go for the gold' in the Regional Apprentice Contest.

Upon successful completion of the five-year apprenticeship program, the Apprentices become Journeymen as Plumbers, Pipefitters and/or Welders.

Our program is affiliated with Laurel Mechanical Contractors Association, and our apprentices work for mechanical contractors who are members of this association.
